University Commons (built in 2016)

Apartment-style, 450-bed facility that houses students in primarily eight-person apartments. Each apartment has four bedrooms, a living room, a full kitchen, and two bathrooms. The building also utilizes the latest security technology by providing access to rooms through the Student ID card.



Residential Commons (2005 and 2007)

Houses 550 students while offering single deluxe rooms and double deluxe rooms with similar suite-style living to University Commons.

OUR COMMITMENT TO EPSILON NU

Delta Tau Delta is drawing up final renovation plans that will accommodate the needs of our brothers and establish a firm foundation for the future of Epsilon Nu. While plans are being finalized, here are our renovation priorities:

Infrastructure

- Move gas meter from front of house and remove abandoned line to old kitchen
- Replace old HVAC units

Kitchen

- Replace kitchen plumbing
- Replace dishwasher
- Install water softener for kitchen
- Replace cabinets and countertops
- Replace yellowed wall panels with SS panels
- Redo floor
- Replace current light ballasts with recessed lighting



Great Room

- Redo floor
- Replace current light ballasts with recessed lighting
- Create combined ritual closet (adjacent to pantry)

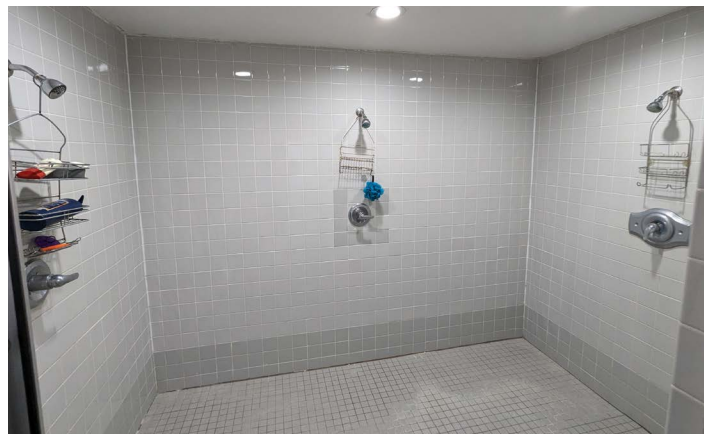
Restrooms Upstairs

- Replace cabinets, countertops, sinks, and bench
- Gut and redo shower (convert to stalled showers)
- Replace all plumbing
- Redo flooring
- Replace stall walls



Restrooms Downstairs

- Replace cabinets, countertops, and sinks
- Redo flooring
- Replace all plumbing
- Improve shower ventilation
- Rewire all electrical
- Replace stall walls



OUR COMMITMENT TO EPSILON NU

Upstairs Public Spaces

- Install additional recessed lighting in hallways
- Install water fountain/bottle filler
- Update all trim to matching throughout
- Patch and paint
- Add more electrical outlets with better accessibility

Student Rooms

- Old wing—Remove laminate wall paneling, insulate walls, and drywall
- Old wing—Add fire doors and standardize door handles
- Replace carpeting
- New desks, new bed frames, new blinds, new ceiling fans
- Install built-in closet storage to improve usability
- Patch and paint

Sleeping Dorms

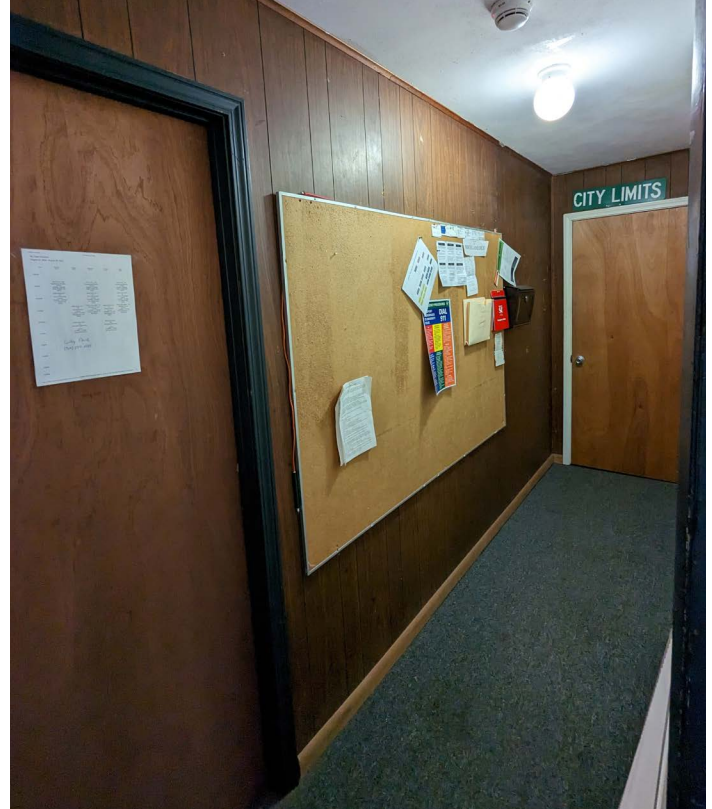
- Complete asbestos abatement

Recreation Room

- Repair foundation next to pool table
- Replace flooring

Outside Areas

- Correct leaning brick sign at street and repair cracking mortar
- Repair chimney to fix draft in adjacent student room.
- Replace hand railings and lift settling sidewalk at front corner
- Replace railroad tie and paver wall with poured concrete wall
- Grade side yard to south of Shelter, backyard around firepit
